Fair, respectful, polite, these are qualities that describe sportsmanlike behavior. This is the type of behavior that is expected of all our club members at events, meetings, and trainings. This behavior is not always intentional. Often, people do not realize their behavior can be harmful to others. As a club, we need to be inclusive and encourage all members to not only participate in events, but to have the experience of hosting events. Seasoned members may become impatient and critical, seeing fault, and identifying failure. This is when it is critical to be supportive, fair, respectful, and polite. The event is never the place to publicly shame or critique.

This shift begins with a conversation. Share your story and discover your courage. As a club, we are generally fair, respectful, and polite to each other, but I have witnessed abusive behavior between club members. It takes tremendous courage and vulnerability to take inventory and make apologies for any behavior that has not been fair, respectful and polite. Discover your courage to stand up when you witness or are the recipient of harassing behavior. Peace is a group effort.
