Course and Birds

Chukar, Quail, and Pheasant may be used in all tests/stakes.

All tests/stakes are single courses with a bird field. You must fire a blank pistol must be fired in the Junior Hunt Test Stakes and for backfield birds in the Senior and Master Hunt Test dog. Shotgun blanks will NOT be allowed in any test. The club does not allow the use of pistols capable of firing live ammunition.

Intro to shotguns and shotgun safety

Learn the basics of handling a shotgun and get to shoot at a few clays. This class is designed to teach you the basics to shooting a shotgun under an experienced instructor. It will teach you how to properly handle, load and fire a shotgun under the watch eye of an instructor. For this course you must wear ear and eye protection. If you don't have ear and or eye protection we can provide you with it. This is open to all ages.

Chukar Shoot

This is a timed event. It would be a timed (15-minute max) event. You can only go out with 5 shells. The fastest time for a handler and his/her dog to harvest three chukars with the least amount of shells spent wins. There are three different categories: Novice (this person can have someone gun for them), Advance, and Senior dog (dog age 9+ years old) Actions will be open when going into the field and shots only taken when it is safe to do so. Note: Dog must point the bird if breaks it's okay. Birds must be shot. Dogs breaking on the shot is okay. Birds can't be shot in the safe zone that can call out

safety, if a bird is in that zone or they don't have a shot because of safety reasons. Birds are only to be shot in the field. There will be 4 birds planted in the field you only get to shoot at 3 birds. The only way you get to go after the 4 birds is if one of the three went into the safety zone and you were able to shoot it and judges called it. If there is a safety , they can move on to the next bird. They will raise hands and yell Time or Done when they have the third bird back in hand. At this time the timer stops the clock and the recorder/data collector writes down the time. You will come back, show how many shells were used and give harvested birds.

Water Test

This is open to all breeds, but only GSP with owners that have active membership with GSPCA will be eligible to receive titles. Water Retrieve Tests are not only fun, but they provide an opportunity for GSP's and their owner to participate in an activity together and for the GSP to demonstrate swimming and retrieving skills just being learned or those already developed. Quite simply: It's all about getting the GSP into the water to retrieve a bird back to the handler, and for the judges to observe the dog's willingness to enter the water, reaction to gun fire, retrieving skills, and response to the handler's commands. The GSP and their handler begin within a 12' diameter circle a few feet from the edge of the water. When the bird is dispatched the judge instructs the handler to release the dog for the retrieve. When released the GSP swims to the bird and retrieves the bird back to their handler within the 12' circle. The GSPCA offers three different levels of water tests, each with their own degree of difficulty. Evaluation by the judges and GSPCA title Certification is based on PASS or FAIL. Dogs do not compete against each other.

DIRECTIONS TO HASTINGS ISLAND HUNTING PRESERVE FROM FAIRFIELD:

Traveling EAST on Hwy 12 toward Rio Vista: Approximately 18 miles from Fairfield, there is a flashing light at the intersection of Hwy 12 and Hwy 113. Turn left on 113 NORTH until coming to another flashing light at the corner of Hwy 113 and Hastings Island Road. EAST: Turn right onto Hastings Road and ½ A mile up the road, there is ascension onto a levee at the intersections of Hastings and Salem Roads. You will see "No Trespassing" Signs. Ignore them! You are now on Hastings Island Road. Obey the 15 MPH speed limit and proceed 3 miles to the clubhouse and SIGN IN!

FROM SACRAMENTO:

Traveling WEST on Hwy 80 toward San Francisco. Take the Pedrick Road exit. Go left over the Freeway and stay on this road until you get to Midway Road. Turn RIGHT to the next intersection that is Hwy 113. Turn LEFT and follow 113 until you see the 2nd flashing light. The road doglegs to the right, but you go straight (WATCH THE CROSS TRAFFIC COMING FROM THE RIGHT) there will be "No Trespassing" signs; ignore them!

FROM RIO VISTA:

Travel WEST on Hwy 12 toward Fairfield. 1 mile past Rio Vista, turn RIGHT onto Church Road, at the end of Church, turn LEFT onto Airport road. One mile further, there will be a "Y" at the intersection with Liberty Island Road. Stay to the RIGHT on Liberty Island Road. Five miles further, the road ascends onto a levee and a bridge that will be on your left. There will be "No Trespassing" signs; ignore them and cross the bridge. You are on the Hastings Island Road
