COURSES/BIRDS/RETRIEVING/GUNS/SAFETY

Chukars, Quail, and Pheasant may be used for all tests. All tests are single course with a bird field. A blank pistol must be fired in the Junior Hunt Test and for backfield birds in Senior and Master Hunt Tests. Shotgun blanks will NOT be allowed in any tests. AKC does not allow the use of pistols capable of firing live ammunition.

An article of orange clothing **MUST** be worn while in the field.

When you arrive at Quail Point, please stop by the office and sign their waiver prior to proceeding to the Hunt test.

We will email confirmation receipt of your entry to a valid email address that you provide.

We will email the running order to all entrants to a valid email address that you provide.

OTHER INFORMATION

- *Overnight camping allowed only in trailers, motor homes, or campers and at the clubhouse only. No hookups available.*
- Water is limited so be sure to bring enough for you and your animals.
- Although we have ordered sunshine, and we hope for dry weather, March can occasionally bring rain, wind, and other weather. Please be prepared for whatever weather the heavens may bestow upon this event
- Entries limited to amount of dogs that can run.

Rules of Quail Point Hunt Preserve

1. **NO SMOKING** on property, except for **INSIDE** your enclosed vehicle.
2. Hunters must park in designated parking areas and are NOT permitted to drive in the fields.
3. Overnight camping allowed only in trailers, motor homes, or campers and at the clubhouse only. No hookups available.
4. **NO HUNTING** allowed on the property unless an authorized agent of Quail Point Hunting Preserve is on the property.
5. Show common courtesy among others. Do not cut in front of others. Do not shoot a crossroads or hills where the view is not clear. No hunting when the fog is dense enough to be unsafe. Guns should be on "safety" while hunting in the field or walking on the Sporting Clays Course. No loaded guns in vehicles or the Clubhouse area. Please strictly adhere to all hunter safety guidelines.
6. Members/hunters are expected to stay on club property, which is clearly marked. **DO NOT CROSS ANY FENCE LINES!** To do so you are trespassing onto neighbor's property.
7. Safety areas are well marked. No shooting into a safety area!
8. No shot size larger than 6 allowed. No high base shells.
9. Everyone **MUST SIGN IN and OUT EACH DAY AT THE CLUBHOUSE DESK.**
10. **HUNTER ORANGE MUST** be worn at all times while hunting. A hat and/or vest are required. Safety glasses are recommended. Hats, vest and glasses are available at the clubhouse desk.
11. No alcoholic beverages are permitted while hunting or on the course. Anyone drinking alcohol or causing disturbances will be discharged from the Club.
12. All members/hunters shall make every effort to find dead or wounded birds.
13. Do not pluck or draw birds in the field. Do not litter the fields with cans, bottles, shell casings etc. Please help keep the premises clean! Please pick up spent shell casings.
14. All dog feces and waste must be removed from the parking lot.
15. **IMPORTANT NOTE:**
Quail Point Hunt Preserve requires a separate liability release be signed by all persons attending this event; handlers, guests, committee members and judges will all be asked to sign this document upon arrival.
